The City Employee Health & Wellness Clinic offers affordable, quality care for employees, spouses, and dependents. You and your family can visit us for urgent care or select our onsite clinician as your primary care physician. There's no charge for service if you're insured by a City health plan. If you're on the CDHP Public Safety Plan, a visit is \$35. If you are not a member of a City health plan, you will pay \$35 (plus \$15 for any required lab work) per visit.
